Improvements to Assist Persons with Disabilities

(RSA 72:37-a)

Improvements to residence such as handicap ramps, lifts, etc. will be exempt from taxation and excluded from the assessed value.

Blind Exemption

\$15,000

(RSA 72:37)

Veteran's Credit

\$250

(RSA 72:28)

Service Connected Total & Permanent Disability

\$700

(RSA 72:35)

An exemption is an amount deducted from the total assessed value of property before the tax is calculated on the property owner's residence.

A tax credit is an amount deducted from the total property tax on the property owner's residence.
