SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

December 14, 2020

Opened with Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 PM

Attendees included Christopher Madden, Chairman of Selectmen, Robert Fee, Selectman, Steve McGerty, Selectman, Michelle Pong, Town Administrator, Harry Power, Compliance Officer and Patricia Putnam, Administrative Assistant. A few members of the public attended.

APPOINTMENTS

7:00 Harry Power – Building Permits and Septic Issues

Harry reported on three Building Permit applications where there are septic issues preventing him from issuing the Building Permits at this time:

- 1. Tax Map # 134, Lot # 39, Jeffrey & Lisa Wolfson, 494 Route 123 North (Island Pond), the property is now seasonal and there is only a holding tank for septic. They are living on the property year round and must install a State Approve Septic System.
- 2. Tax Map # 131, Lot # 7, Leland Chick, 685 Route 123 North (Island Pond), The property is seasonal and there is nothing on file for a State Approved Septic System, The system was supposed to be installed in August but nothing has been done.
- 3. Tax Map # 115, Lot # 66, The Seven Trust, 80 Tigola Trail, Is on the market as a five bedroom residence. The property is seasonal and there is no septic system on file. There must be a State Approved Septic System installed before the buyer can live there year round.

Harry also read letters from Town Attorney Matt Serge and NH Municipal Association Attorney Stephen Buckley regarding the Town's practice of issuing Town Building Permits. Both attorneys agreed that the Town is not required to enforce State Building Codes; it requires the contractor of the building to follow the State Building and Fire Codes. VII: reads "No municipalities shall be held liable for any failure on the part of the contractor to comply with the provisions of the State Building Codes. He also referred to Title VI, concerning the Freedom of Expression between employers and employees.

- 4. Cemetery Commission Appointment Bruce Bell appointed.
- 5. Trustee of the Trust Funds Appointment Richard Nicoletti Chris Madden moved and Bob Fee seconded to appoint Richard Nicoletti to fill the term until the end of Town Meeting, 2023, the board agreed.
- 6. Supervisor of the Checklist Resignation Patricia Marotta Bob Fee moved and Steve McGerty seconded to accept the resignation, the board so voted.
