- 1. Michelle Pong reported receiving a report of Bass Tournaments scheduled with the Town urging parking the vehicles and trailers at the School and having shuttle service to get fishing participants back and forth. The Conservation Commission is concerned with the treatment of fish caught during the tournaments. They are urging that fish be released away from the boat landing.
- 2. Stephen McGerty asked about the research of having the alarm systems at the buildings be contracted with SW mutual Aid. Michelle Pong reported that the alarm systems would be more cost effective with SWFMA that the present monitor. Michelle will research changing over.
- 3. Stephen McGerty asked about Reverse E911 the school has that service in place but for only their students. Michelle will check into that service for the town.

- 4. Stephen McGerty asked about P/R direct deposit. Michelle Pong said that she will be signing up for that service in the near future. The receipts will be placed in the Fire Department's mailbox at the Gould House for payees to know how much \$\$ has been deposited to accounts.
- 5. Stephen McGerty asked if a private vehicle is allowed to tow the Fire Department's trailer. Michelle Pong will check with Primex, the Town's insurance Agent.
- 6. Stephen McGerty asked if there has been any answer on the excessive electrical costs at the Old Fire Station. Michelle Pong reported that she has been kept on hold by Eversource and has gotten no answer. It was decided to unplug everything except the trickle charger for the vehicle and see if there is any relief in the cost.
