Computer & CAD - is budget large enough to acquire program? Matthew Wheeler reported that Conservation Commission member, Scott Semmens, has the equipment and program and that the program could cost between \$4,000. and \$40,000. Matthew is working with Scott to produce some examples of maps that might fill the need that the Planning Board has in order to define parcels where the slopes are too steep for development.

Interim Budget Report - Ruth reported that very little has been expended in the current budget. Most expenditures haven't been made due to when payments are required.

Monadnock Boat Store (Chessie Holdings, LLC) - a copy of the Approval to Construct their septic system has been received. They plan to have it functioning by the end of November.

Cell Tower Ordinance update - Ruth went over the suggested comments by Terry McMahon. The board agreed to some of his observations and the changes to the Model Telecommunications Facilities Ordinance to come into compliance with Stoddard's concerns and existing regulations.
