SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES

November 19, 2018

- 5. Discuss USDA grant for Town Hall accessibility improvements –it was decided to have Jim Coffey investigate options to replace the handicapped ramp.

Charlie Fosberry reported that he has inspected the siding that has been installed on part of the building and found it to be metal and gray. The agreed upon siding was to be white vinyl Siding. The agreement was to be paid upon completion of the job. The board decided to hold off on any payment until the next board meeting.
