Minutes of the June 19, 2017 meeting

Call to order: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the library.

Librarian's Report:

Summer is an exciting time at Davis Public Library!

The students at the JFES walked to the library today to learn about the summer reading program and explore the library. This program will kick off at 2 PM on the 26th with local authors Sandra and Rich Wallace who will introduce their book on Jonathan Daniels.

Many more children's activities have been scheduled. Details at the library.

Shea Sterreh will teach yoga on Monday nights in July at 6:30 beginning the 10th.

In April, the library had 179 patrons, 152 items were borrowed from DPL, there were 29 uses of the computer, and no museum passes were used. In addition, 26 items were borrowed from the Interlibrary Loan program, and 153 from NH Downloadable Books for a total of 331 for the month. We have 6 new patrons, and 12 participated in Book Club.

In May, the library had 218 patrons, 143 items were borrowed from DPL, there were 47 uses of the computer, and no museum passes were used. In addition,2 items were borrowed from the Interlibrary Loan program, and 139 from NH Downloadable Books for a total of 284 for the month. We have 7new patrons, and 13 participated in Book Club. The library was closed for 1 holiday.

Minutes of the April Meeting were approved as written with the addition of the newsletter. It was decided to continue our funding of the newsletter as long as our donations exceed the cost of printing and distribution.

Treasurer's Report was approved as written. Lauren requested \$100 gift card for purchases relating to the Summer Reading Program. This was approved and Brenda will get her a \$100 prepaid Visa card. 60 members have paid dues since the fiscal year began July 1, 2016.
