#### OLD BUSINESS

1. Review/Approve 2023-2024 Budget for Warrant
2. Review following articles for warrant:
  1. Delete Article XII, Section 4 b of the Community Planning Ordinance that currently reads “An application must be made to the Zoning Board of Adjustment for a special exception for any change in the use of wetlands.” ON THE BALLOT
  2. Shall we adopt the provisions of RSA 466:30-a which make it unlawful for any dog to run at large, except when accompanied by the owner or custodian, and when used for hunting, herding, supervised competition and exhibition or training for such? ON THE BALLOT
  3. To see if the Town of Stoddard will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$80,768.00 for the purpose of purchasing 40 acres of forestland with 4,000 feet of undeveloped shoreline on Highland Lake to be returned to the General Fund in full, no later than December 2024. (Majority vote required). NOT ON THE BALLOT, BUT BALLOT VOTE CAN BE REQUESTED AT TOWN MEETING
  4. To see if the Town will vote to establish the Board of Selectmen as Agents for the Recreation Fund, currently managed by the Trustee of Trust Funds with unknown or vague origins. Going forward, the intent of the fund is to support local recreation, celebrations and other uses deemed appropriate by the Board of Selectmen. Majority vote required. CURRENTLY RESEARCHING THE LEGAL IMPLICATIONS OF THIS FUND
  5. Discuss eliminating the Planning Board and ZBA articles and instead including those in the General Operating Budget.
  6. Other Articles to include in the General Operating Budget? Police, Fire, Ambulance, Emergency Management, Solid Waste, Highway, Conservation Commission, Lake Host, Cemeteries.
3. Set Date for Public Hearing and Budget Hearing – After April 9, before April 14
4. Pest Control at Gould House
5. Staffing at Town Clerk/Tax Collector Office
