Article 01 Election of Officers

To choose one commissioner for a term of three years, and to see who the inhabitants of the District will elect for the offices of treasurer, moderator, clerk each for one year. Nominations for commissioner, Derek MacAllister; moderator, John Halter; treasurer, Robert Maden; clerk, Sally Ripley.

Article 02 Capital Reserve Fund Transfer

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$40,000 to be added to the Dam Capital Reserve Fund for the purpose of dam maintenance, repair, and/or replacement. This fund was previously established in December 2008. A sum of \$40,000 to be raised from taxation. Commissioners recommend passage of this article. (Majority vote required.)

Article 03 General Operating Expenses

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,750 for Village District expenses. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. Commissioners recommend passage of this article. (Majority vote required)

Article 04 Repairs to spillway pins, boards and concrete.

To see if the Village District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,500 to upgrade the spillway pins and summer boards, and to conduct minor concrete repairs on the spillway. The sum of \$2,500 to be raised from taxation. Commissioners recommend passage of this article. (Majority vote required)

Article 05 Deep Draw Down

To see if the Village District will vote to lower the water level of Granite Lake approximately three feet below the normal winter draw down (approximately two feet) beginning on or about September 1, 2024. (Majority vote required.)

Article 06 Next Annual Meeting Date

To see if the Village District will vote to hold its next Annual Village District Meeting on Saturday, April 26, 2025, at 10:00 AM at The Chapel By-The-Lake, in Munsonville, NH.
