Transportation Needs to the DOT – What does the town need done from the DOT in the Town of Stoddard over the next 5 years? Get a list together for DOT due by the end of October. Some suggestions, Culvert checks, Sight along Route 9 including at Juniper Hill Road and the access to the Town Beach on Route 123 North.

Septic Agreement with Keene – **Robert motioned to sign. Christopher Seconded. Motion Carried.**

Powerline Road ( Public vs Private) – After some looking it was found that Powerline Road is a Private Road.

Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Contract – County Funds to be distributed to municipalities over the course of 2 years. Applications have been filled out.

Stephen McGerty – The bridge has been paved. Kings Highway to Turtle Rock Road has also been paved.

Stephen McGerty – Has Waste Management been notified that Pat is passing out the new dump stickers that start in January?

Stephen McGerty - The Town of Marlow Fire Dept. is having an open burn training on Private Property in Stoddard. The Stoddard Fire Dept. has been invited to participate.

Stephen McGerty – Who owns the Reed Road Cemetery? Harry answered that the Town does and it is maintained by a private citizen by approval of the Cemetery Commission.

Stephen McGerty – All the decals have been taking off the Rescue Truck going to Auction.

Stephen McGerty – The Fire Dept. purchase of helmets, vests & bags, was the money returned to the Dept. it was believed to be a grant. Michelle believes the money was returned to the Dept. but will check and make sure and get back to Stephen.

Thank you letter from Stoddard Elementary School – Michelle wanted it noted in the minutes that they have done a lot of work out there and are appreciative of the Town support. They are also looking to level an area for a 5 X 5 storage shed.
