## 1. Correspondence

- Geri has submitted a preliminary budget to the Select Board.
- A Stoddard resident of Hidden Lake has requested to park a
  vehicle in the DPL parking area for a week. Consensus is that the
  vehicle could be an obstruction to other activities and therefore
  to deny permission.
- Angel will send a thank you to Ken Young for painting and storing the shutters.

## 2. Treasurer's report.

• Checking - \$894.94; Savings - \$5625.81; Donation Acc't- \$16,221.00

#### 3. Library Director

- Extra hours 81 hrs. are budgeted, 9 are for cataloguing.
- An edible plants program is planned with the Marlow Library. Justin Gardner's fee of \$100 will be split with the Marlow Library, costing the DPL \$50.
- Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup>, Preston Hiller, a Mentalist will present a program at 7pm. Attendance will be free, but attendees will be encouraged to bring food items to donate to the Community Kitchen.
- The Summer Reading Program theme will be animal stories.
- Other educational programs under consideration are: essential oils, yoga.
- Grant
  - \* \$500.00 has been set aside for the gazebo ramp. The Millbrook Woodworks Farm people are in Pennsylvania and will be contacted as soon as they return.
  - \* Lauren will look for a bulletin board for the Library entryway for community notices.
  - \* Lauren plans to use a #14 cloth hanging system in the Children's Room.
- Catogloguing- Lauren is meeting with Charlotte May 10. She plans to try using her 30hrs for cataloguing at a rate of 10 hrs/week.
